EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES: TRAUMA, EMERGENT SURGERY (RED SERVICE) PGY-4

OBJECTIVES:

Demonstrate an understanding of the pathophysiologic effect of blunt and penetrating trauma.

Demonstrate the ability to effectively manage the surgical care of a patient with complex multisystem injuries.

Demonstrate knowledge of and the ability to manage a variety of healthcare services for trauma patients such as transportation, emergency room and in-hospital care, and rehabilitation.

PATIENT CARE:

- 1. Manage blunt and penetrating injuries through understanding the injury potential of wounding mechanisms.
- 2. Provide management for pre-existing disease states in injured patients with appropriate consultation.
- 3. Perform all operative and management procedures for trauma to the chest, abdomen, extremities, and head with direct supervision.
- 4. Perform and/or supervise application of the full range of supportive technology in the management of trauma victims. (a full range of airway management options, vascular access options, resuscitative strategies, etc.)
- 5. Direct rehabilitation plans with appropriate consultation.
- 6. Coordinate EMS activities for initial trauma management to include instructional programs.
- 7. Organize hospital resources to provide services for trauma patients in the emergency department, operating room, and intensive care unit.
- 8. Provide appropriate referrals for vocation rehabilitation, nursing home services, and physical rehabilitation.
