I. Purpose of Policy

The use of Restrictive Covenants must not be included in a Resident's Agreement of Appointment for a Resident training in an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME)-accredited residency or fellowship program at Dartmouth Hitchcock (DH).

II. Policy Scope

The policy applies to Graduate Medical Education (GME) staff and Program Directors for ACGME-accredited residency and fellowship programs at DH.

III. Definitions

- Agreement of Appointment: The document which identifies information on stipends, benefits (inclusive of health insurance accessible to Residents and their eligible dependents), professional liability coverage, and disability insurance.
- **Resident**: Any physician in an ACMGE-accredited GME program including residents and fellows.
- **Restrictive Covenant**: A non-competition guarantee in which an employee agrees not to enter or start a similar profession or trade in competition against the employer.

IV. Policy Statement

- The ACGME specifically prohibits the use of Restrictive Covenants in a Resident's agreement.
- Neither Dartmouth Hitchcock/Mary Hitchcock Memorial Hospital as the Sponsoring Institution, nor any of its ACGME-accredited training programs, require that a Resident sign a Restrictive Covenant.
